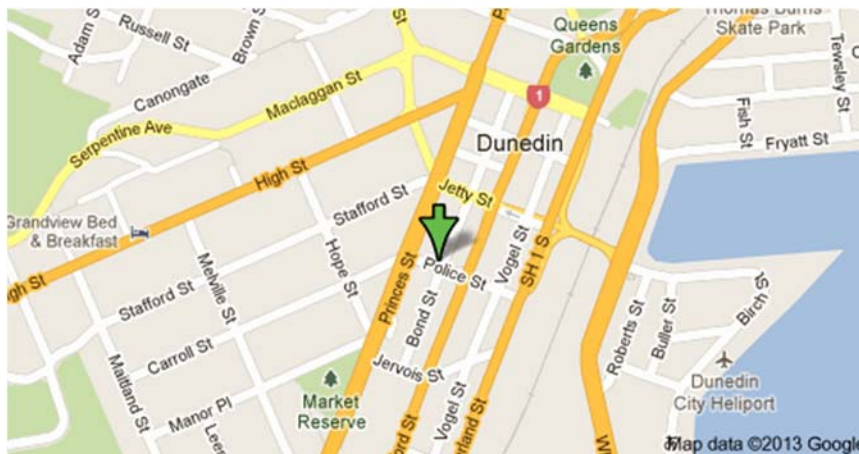
Entries close at 10pm on Thursday 5 September

### Competition format

#### Individual

One round of pools followed by direct elimination.

Genders will be separate unless there are insufficient entries of one gender in an event.

#### Teams

The format for teams will be decided to fit the time allotted when the number of teams has been confirmed.

Composite teams from a region may be permitted if any schools in a region have insufficient fencers to make up a team.

## **Equipment Requirements**

Clothing: Minimum of - 350N Jacket/800N plastron OR 800N Jacket/350N plastron, 350N Breeches, 350N Mask

Blades: FIE Foil and Epee blades, S2000 or later Sabre blades

Foil Masks: lame bibs are required, retro fits are accepted

Please go through Weapons Check on Friday evening if you are able to. Weapons Check will be available before events, however, there will be a queue, and you risk not getting your gear checked in time.

## **Travel**

We strongly advise you **NOT** to book flights to or from Dunedin on the same day as you compete. We will do our best, but we cannot guarantee events will run to time.

Note that Dunedin airport is 20-30 minutes out of the city. You will need to factor this into your travel time. An airport shuttle is much cheaper than getting a taxi: [www.supershuttle.co.nz](http://www.supershuttle.co.nz) or [www.kiwishuttles.co.nz](http://www.kiwishuttles.co.nz). In addition to Air NZ, Jetstar fly direct Auckland-Dunedin.
