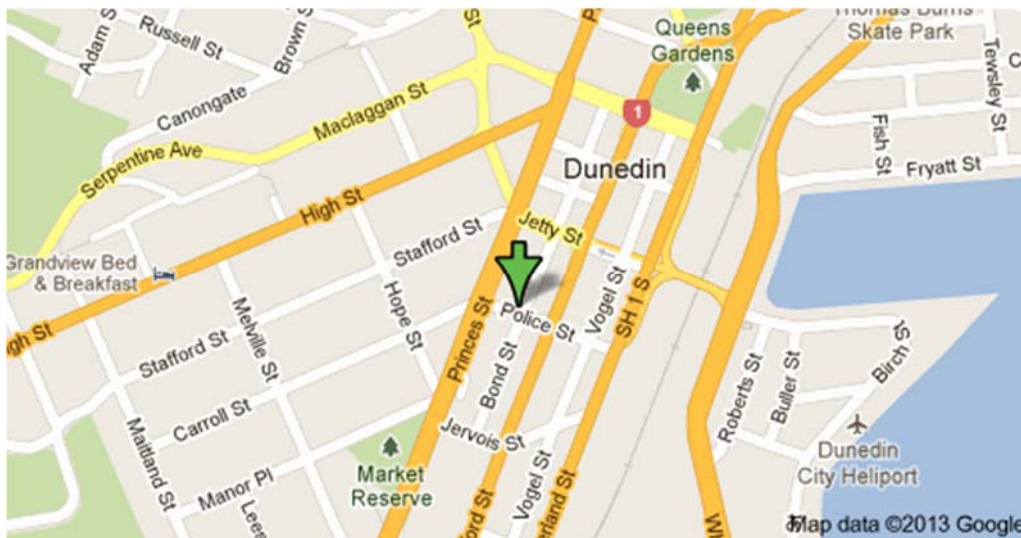
Entries close at 7pm on Thursday 26 September.

Equipment Requirements

Clothing: Minimum of - 350N Jacket/800N plastron OR 800N Jacket/350N plastron, 350N Breeches, 350N Mask

Blades: FIE Foil and Epee blades, S2000 or later Sabre blades

Foil Masks: lame bibs are required, retro fits are accepted

Please go through Weapons Check on Friday evening if you are able to. Weapons Check will be available before events, however, there will be a queue, and you risk not getting your gear checked in time.

Travel

We strongly advise you **NOT** to book flights to or from Dunedin on the same day as you compete.

Dunedin airport is 20 minutes out of the city. You will need to factor this into your travel time. An airport shuttle is much cheaper than getting a taxi: www.supershuttle.co.nz or www.kiwishuttles.co.nz. In addition to Air NZ, Jetstar fly direct Auckland-Dunedin.
